

RAJASTHAN FIRST STATE TO GET L-ROOT SERVER

Rajasthan has become the first State in the country to get the L-root server, which will enable it to provide digital services and enforce e-governance with seamless connectivity.

The new facility will strengthen infrastructure and help improve security of Internet-based operations. The new server has been installed at the Bhamashah State Data Centre here in association with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers. Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot said Internet operations would continue to run in State without any interruption.
