

NAGALAND CASELOAD DIPS TO ZERO

Nagaland became a coronavirus-free State on Sunday with the lone active COVID patient from Dimapur district recovering from the infection, a senior Health Department official said.

The active case count hit zero for the first time in the northeastern State since the detection of three COVID patients on May 25, 2020, he said.

The caseload remained at 35,488 as no fresh infection was reported in the last 24 hours, the official said
