As per the reports of the State Governments, no person is engaged as manual scavenger any i.e. carrying of human excreta from insanitary latrines, any more. There are certain claims from some voluntary agencies that still there are some people working as manual scavengers. However they could not substantiate these claims.

Although no deaths have been reported from manual scavenging, 309 deaths have been reported during the last five years of people who undertook hazardous cleaning of sewers and septic tanks.

Details of number of manual scavengers provided assistance for their rehabilitation by Government during the last five years, year-wise and State-wise under the Self Employment Scheme for Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers, is given at **Annexure-I.** In Madurai, 02 manual scavengers have been identified and they have been provided One time Cash Assistance of Rs. 40,000/-
