The Government has notified S.O. 1522 (E) dated 6th April, 2018 fixing maximum speed of motor vehicles in kilometres per hour on different categories of roads:-

5.	Quadricycle	-	60	50	50
6.	Three wheeled vehicles	-	50	50	50
