

# LICENCES OF FIRMS THAT MADE SYRUPS LINKED TO CHILD DEATHS REVOKED

Indonesia's food and drug agency revoked the licences of two firms to distribute materials used in syrup medicines linked to a wave of child deaths caused by kidney failure or damage.
