

FIR AGAINST OWNERS OF CATTLE HIT BY VANDE BHARAT TRAIN

The Railway Protection Force (RPF) in Gujarat registered a case against the owners of the four buffaloes that were hit by the Mumbai-Gandhinagar Vande Bharat Express, in which the front portion of the train was damaged, officials said on Friday. The nose cone cover of the driver coach of the semi-high speed train, which got damaged after hitting the buffaloes, was replaced with a new one in Mumbai, the Western Railways said in a statement. In the second such incident in two days, the Vande Bharat Express train on Friday hit a cow near Anand in Gujarat while on its way to Mumbai, officials said. PTI
